

ORDINANCE NO. 275

ORDINANCE REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Casselton, North Dakota that an ordinance establishing rules for removal of snow within the City of Casselton is hereby enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person to place, pile, or blow snow from any private property, driveway or sidewalk onto the streets of the City. This shall not apply, however, to the removal of snow from sidewalks in the business district of the City, provided that such snow is placed on the street prior to the time the City has removed the snow from the street.

SECTION 2. The City may remove any such snow deposited on the street in violation of this ordinance and may charge the cost of such removal to the owner of the property from which the snow came.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a non-criminal infraction and may be fined a maximum of \$500.00 as determined by the Municipal Judge

SECTION 4. If the violator fails to pay the fine within 30 days of being found guilty, the City of Casselton may assess the fine against violator's taxes if he or she owns real estate within the City of Casselton.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
