

Ordinance No. 278

PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASSELTON, CASS COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, ORDINANCE NO. 166 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic beverages or possess an open container of alcoholic beverages on any public property and/or any property maintained by the City within the following described areas:


Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the Burlington Northern Railway tracks and 6th Avenue; thence east along the center line of the Burlington Northern Railway right-of-way to a point where the Burlington Northern center line intersects with the southerly extension of 9th Avenue; thence North along the center line of 9th Avenue North to the intersection of 9th Avenue North and the easterly extension of the center line of the Block Six, Original Townsite alley; thence west along the center line of the Block Six, Original Townsite alley, to the intersection of the westerly extension of the center line of the Block Six, Original Townsite alley and the center line of 8th Avenue North; thence North along the center line of 8th Avenue North to the intersection of the center line of 8th Avenue North and the center line of 1st Street North; thence west along the center line of 1st Street North to the intersection of the center line of 1st Street North and the center line of 6th Avenue North, thence south along the center line of 6th Avenue North to the point of beginning.

ARTICLE II. The City Council may, upon resolution, waive the provisions of this ordinance for a specified location and period of time not to exceed four consecutive days.

ARTICLE III. The prohibition in Article I shall not apply to bar/restaurant patio areas which are designated as part of the on-sale licensed premises.


ARTICLE IV. Penalty. The penalty for violation of the above sections shall be in accordance with the general penalty provisions of the Casselton Municipal Court, but in no event shall any fine levied be less than \$50.00.

ARTICLE V. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force effective upon its final reading and passage.
