This was an informal meeting for the city engineer to present information to the land owners in the Industrial Park and to get their feedback on Storm Sewer Improvements for the area. The voiced opinion was to 1) ditch along the west side of the industrial park to get water coming from the west to flow north to the swale that flows east and into the Swan Creek diversion, 2) take water from the southeast corner of the industrial park north along the east side of highway 18 to the same swale going into the Swan Creek diversion, 3) add a deeper culvert at the intersection of highway 18 and the off ramp of Interstate 29 which would allow the water to flow east on the north side of the interstate, 4) not dig a larger retention pond due to the immense cost of the project. Although Oye believes a larger pond will still be needed, he will present the ideas discussed to council and request work to get grade elevations to see if the options are feasible.
