Old Business

1. Garbage truck shed

Councilman Anderson is putting together a plan to skin the exterior of the building. It was also discussed that the alley will be built up and graded.

2. Sewer and street project update

City engineer Brandon Oye gave the committee an update on the project. Sewer relining should be completed by Oct 31, the old lift station on 8th Ave S will be removed on Oct 22, 1st St S should be completed by Oct 23 and reopened sometime next week, the contractor that is doing the asphalt will be leaving this week and returning next week sometime.

3. US Heat

They have requested if their sewer rates could be lowered, as most of the water used goes into evaporation towers. It was decided that if they could put in a separate meter for just the cooling tower that their rates could be adjusted. Public Works Supervisor will talk to them.

4. 6th Ave N parking

There has been a request that the committee look at the possibility of eliminating the parking on the center of the street. It was decided that the parking would stay as is, due to limited parking in this area. An effort will be made to put up no parking signs on the center of the street when temporary traffic changes dictate.

5. Otter Tail Power contract

Otter Tail sent a contract to the city for street light maintenance on city owned lights. Mayor McConnell will contact them about the contract.

6. The mayor suggested that the Public Works Committee meet with all the city employees, to introduce themselves.
