Public Works Committee Meeting

Council members present, Lee Anderson, Mike Eberhardt, Joan Carvel, and Mayor Ed McConnell. Public Works Supervisor Kevin Mayer

Kevin presented to the committee the two options available to the city regarding the dike between highway 18 and county road 10. The DOT is working on a new crossover between the two highways and the dike will have to be redone. Option one is for the city to opt out of the federal levee program until the construction is finished and the dike is recertified. Option two would be to have the DOT submit plans and specs to the CORP for prior approval and have the new dike completed before the existing dike is removed.

The committee chose option two because if the other option was used the city would not have any Federal assistance in the event of a flood during the construction.

Kevin reported his findings on having a pedestrian crosswalk installed on Langer Ave S between Cottonwood Drive and Morningside Drive. The committee made the decision that if a crosswalk was installed on Langer Ave South it would be at Fairway Drive and 7th St S. The recommendation was made to continue to look into this area and what more would be required from the DOT.

The committee was presented with a current list of city owned equipment for their review. It was discussed that the equipment is aging and that we need to keep on with a replacement program. The recycling bailer will need to be replaced in 2013.

Mayor McConnell explained to the committee his thoughts on street repair project. He directed the committee to come up with a plan for street repairs and a time frame for doing it.

The committee directed the Public Works Department to make the speed bump installed by someone on 1st St N to remove it.
