Did you know?

- ✓ The city cemetery was moved to its present location sometime between 1880 and 1884.
- √ The total area is approximately 18 acres.
- ✓ The city cemetery is governed by a volunteer board and managed by cemetery manager.
- ✓ Revenue comes from sales of plots, burial fees, government grants the board will apply for, donations from citizens and city support.
- ✓ The city cemetery depends on volunteers for a variety of maintenance tasks.

 Maintenance of the grounds is needed from April November. There is a list of ideas below, but any help or projects not listed are also appreciated! Groups or individuals are both welcome.

Ongoing Maintenance Opportunities

- ✓ Weed & water plants at entrance.
- ✓ Sweep the grass off the monuments and grave markers.
- ✓ Pick up branches after a storm.
- ✓ Water freshly planted graves.
- ✓ Tree trimming low branches from the ground.
- ✓ Other tasks as needed.

Major Improvement Opportunities

- ✓ Install new plants near entrance or other locations throughout the cemetery.
- ✓ Plant new trees.
