ORDINANCE # 246

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASSELTON, CASS  
COUNT, NORTH DAKOTA:

Introduction

Whereas, the laws of the State of North Dakota and the Home Rule Charter of the City of Casselton allow the City to provide for the operation of golf carts on City streets; so now therefore:

Section 1, Golf Carts on City Streets

Golf carts may be operated on city streets in the City of Casselton only under the following conditions and subject to the following restrictions: 1) Golf carts may be operated only by persons with valid driver's licenses during daytime travel between the owner's place of residence and the golf course; 2) Golf cart operators must obey and are subject to all state and local traffic laws that motor vehicles are subject to; 3) Golf carts may not be operated on federal, state or county highways, except for the perpendicular crossing of these highways.

Section 2. Penalty. A violation of this ordinance shall be considered an infraction, punishable by a \$20 fine for a first offense and punishable by a \$20-\$100 fine for any subsequent offenses.

Section 3. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after August 1, 2007, and all existing ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
